Napa County Mosquito Abatement District has been controlling mosquito populations for the citizens of Napa County since 1925. There are currently eight employees who are responsible for reducing mosquito levels throughout the County.


Your Mosquito Abatement District is asking for your assistance and cooperation, in order to more effectively reduce mosquito populations in your area. Please use our checklist and suggestions for control of mosquitoes in your yard.

One container filled with water can produce thousands of mosquitoes during the spring and summer. These mosquitoes can bite you, your pets and your neighbors that are within one-quarter of a mile of their breeding site.

Your District routinely controls mosquitoes in places such as vacant fields, roadside ditches, storm drains, septic systems, marshes and stock ponds. Every effort is made to prevent the emergence of adult mosquitoes by killing the immature stages in the water. Your cooperation will help us minimize the effects of these biting insects.

A general rule for preventing the production of mosquitoes is:



NO STANDING WATER = NO MOSQUITOES!

Keep dry, drain, correct leaky plumbing, Prevent or remove accumulation of rain or **Plastic Covers** dripping air conditioning or refrigeration, and **Basements** sprinkler water on covers. install a sump pump. Keep clean so that water does not stand. Rain Gutters **Birdbaths** Change water frequently, at least once a week. Keep tightly covered and or buried to prevent **Septic Tanks** Store small boats upside down, cover large mosquito entrance. boats to prevent accumulation of water, keep **Boats** Keep chlorinated, if not in use tightly cover drains open. and keep rainwater from accumulating on the Spas and **Hot Tubs** Do not place litter or garden debris into these cover. Stock with fish if no longer to be used and never pour used motor oil or other as a spa or hot tub. Catch Basins & **Storm Drains** materials into them as the oil eventually goes into the bay. **Standing Water** Eliminate by draining or filling.
